Joe Garassino, 28, grew up in Watertown, CT and was building his career when he was diagnosed with intrahepatic cholangiocarcinoma or cancer of the bile duct in June, 2012. His cancer was aggressive and unstoppable and seven months later on January 20, 2013, Joe died. While cancer overtook Joe's body, it never altered his indomitable spirit. Joe was deeply loved by his family and friends and we knew how much he loved all of us.

The Joe Garassino Foundation was founded by his dad, Mike Garassino in honor and memory of Joe. The Foundation's goal is to support research and build awareness for rare cancers and other cancers. It strives to be a beacon of light and hope for individuals and their families facing a cancer crisis by offering financial support from the local community.
